The following information is designed to assist in the preparation and placement of election signs and hoardings. A list of the Conditions and Approved Sites follows:

CONDITIONS

1. Extreme care must be taken when digging holes for sign supports as underground power, telephone, water and gas services may exist at any depth below the surface.
2. Maximum size of any election hoards is set at 2.4 square metres in face area, although some sites require a maximum size of 1 sq metre.
3. Signs shall be erected no earlier than 42 days before the election for local authority elections and 2 months in the case of general elections in accordance with the Electoral Regulations 2008.
4. Signs to be removed prior to the day of the election.
5. All election hoardings must be maintained in a tidy and safe state at all times.
6. Signs must be located so that they do not obstruct traffic sight lines from intersections, driveways, pedestrian and railway crossings.
7. Signs must not obstruct the clear view of any traffic signs or other hoardings/community notice boards erected in the vicinity.
8. On removal of the hoardings, the ground must be restored to its former condition.
9. For signs on private property, the following provisions of the District Plan apply: Any clarifications on District Plan rules contact Environmental Consents Division 04-570-6666.

Activity Areas	Maximum Size
Residential	2.4 sq.metres face area
Recreation	3 sq.metres total sign
Commercial and Business	20 sq metres face area, but some restricted street frontages. Maximum height of free standing sign 8 metres.

10. Mobile Signs – No signs are permitted anywhere on The Esplanade, Eastern Hutt Road and Randwick Road.

ELECTION HOARDING - APPROVED SITES

See plans attached for exact locations allowed.

- (a) **Wainuiomata Road** – west side on grass berm, 110m north of Puriri Street to be visible only to north bound traffic.
- (b) **Waione Street, Seaview** (*Signs 1 sq metres only (Maximum height to top of sign = 1.8m)*) – north side of the road only on grass berm, between the existing Community Information Sign and 20m back from the Estuary Bridge.
- (c) **Waione Street - Median Strip** – at least 68m clear of Kirkcaldy Street intersection and not closer than 2m from the kerb edge.
- (d) **Parkside Road** on grass berm - stream side only, 20m east of the entrance to Hutt Park Holiday Park, but not within 60 metres of the level crossing and 30m back from Bell Road intersection.
- (e) **Harbourview Road** – 15m back from first house on left hand side going uphill from SH2, but no more than 75m.
- (f) **Normandale Road** (*Signs 1 sq metres only*) - South side in the gully area 80m back from Normandale Bridge heading uphill.
- (g) **Major Drive** - north side at the bottom of the hill from the entrance to the recycling station and uphill for 50m before the first bend.
- (h) **Fairway Drive** – south side only – 155 metres west from GNS Science driveway and 50m east from the ramp from Harcourt Werry Drive. No sign to block visibility to the existing Community Information Sign (*See plan for extent of area allowed*).
- (i) **Pharazyn Street** - on the railway berm at least 80 metres south of the Block Road intersection.
- (j) **Vogel Street/Naenae Road intersection** on Mildenhall Park - and not closer than 5 metres to any kerblines.
- (k) **Oxford Terrace/Pohutukawa Street** (*No Plan, See attached plan of non approved sites*)– on the railway berms only, except the frontage of Waterloo and Woburn Stations.
- (l) **Cambridge Terrace** (*No Plan, See attached plan of non approved sites*) - on the railway berms only, except the frontage of Waterloo and Woburn Stations.

- (m) **Wingate Roundabout-High Street to Oxford Terrace** - at least 5 metres back behind any kerblines, except on the south side corner facing High Street at least 9 metres back behind kerblines and only on the large central island.
- (n) **Wingate Crescent** - on any of the grassed areas north and south of the Wingate Overbridge, at least 5m back behind any kerblines and 30m clear of the northern intersection & 40m clear of the southern intersection.
- (o) **High Street** (*No Plan, See attached plan of non approved sites*) - on the railway berm, south of the Taita Shops.
- (p) **George Street** - east side at the southern end Delaney Park between the fence and the road.
- (q) **Stokes Valley Road** – On recreation reserve land at the entrance to Stokes Valley, on the east side of Stokes Valley Road south of Wagon Road.
