Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 30 September 2023 for:

- The total contestable fund amount capped at in the current year.
 Answer: The budget for 2023 2024 includes a base budget of \$157,900 and a carry over budget of \$41,250, coming to \$199,150 in total.
- The number of applications Council receive typically per year and the average amount granted.
 Answer: In the financial year 2021 2022, Council received three heritage fund applications and a sum of \$6,593.16 was granted to one case.

Five heritage fund applications were recieved by Council in the financial year 2022 2023 and a total amount of \$90,033.99 was granted to five cases.

In most cases, grant disbursement occurs upon the completion of the physical work. For instance, four out of the five cases that received grants in 2022 2023 were applications from previous years.

The percentage of historic heritage resource consents that make up the total number of resource consents applied for in Hutt City a year.
 Answer: The percentage of heritage consents that come in range from 0.5 1% each year.
